

Mpact Recycling Ronnie Recycler Schools Competition Terms and Conditions 2022



Collect white office paper, brown corrugated cardboard boxes, mixed paper, plastic PET bottles and glass beverage bottles (see specific grades for your region) and stand a chance to win a share of R110 000* for your school. If the collections for your school are regular and in total amounts to 4 tonnes (4 000kg) for the nine month period referred to below, your school will stand a chance to win a share of the prizes. Schools will continue to be paid for their collections as per the standard procedure for your specific region.

The five regions participating in the competition are:

- Gauteng - Johannesburg North & East
- Gauteng - Johannesburg South & West
- Gauteng - Pretoria
- Kwa Zulu Natal
- Western Cape

Grades per Region:

- Gauteng: white office paper, brown corrugated cardboard boxes, plastic PET bottles and glass beverage bottles
- Kwa Zulu Natal: mixed paper (including newspaper), white office paper, brown corrugated cardboard boxes, plastic PET bottles and glass beverage bottles
- Western Cape: mixed paper (including newspaper), white office paper, brown corrugated cardboard boxes, plastic PET bottles and glass beverage bottles

Prizes are as follows for each region:

1st Prize:

- For your school: R7 000**
- Green Ambassador: R1 000 (Makro voucher)
- Green Learner: R1 000 (Makro voucher)

2nd Prize:

- For your school: R4 000**

3rd Prize:

- For your school: R2 000**

4th - 10th Prize:

- For your school: R1 000**

The competition runs from 1st February 2022 - 31st October 2022. The green ambassador and green learner are chosen by the winning school. Any misrepresentation, misdescription & or nondisclosure by the school shall render the entry voidable.

Tiebreakers will be dealt with by means of a draw to determine 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.

Winners must reside in the Republic of South Africa. The winners must be able to travel to the participating Mpact Recycling branch and should any costs including travelling be incurred it will be for the winners' account.
